

Home Resources: Early Years Activity

Baby Owls

Make your own Sarah or Percy or Bill with our 'Baby Owl Prints' activity.



What you need

- Black and brown construction paper
- White paint
- Clothes peg
- Craft pom-pom
- Tray/plate for the paint
- Glue
- Scissors
- Black crayon or marker

What to do

1. Pour a thin layer of paint into a tray.
2. Clip a clothes peg onto a pom-pom to create a simple stamper.
3. Dip the pom-pom into the white paint and dab it onto a piece of black paper to create an owl body shape.
4. Cut out shapes from brown paper to create the eyes, beak and feet.
5. When the paint is dry, glue the features on. Use a black crayon to draw a small circle in the centre of the eyes.

What they can learn

- Hand-eye coordination
- Creativity
- Fine motor skills
- Understanding patterns and texture
