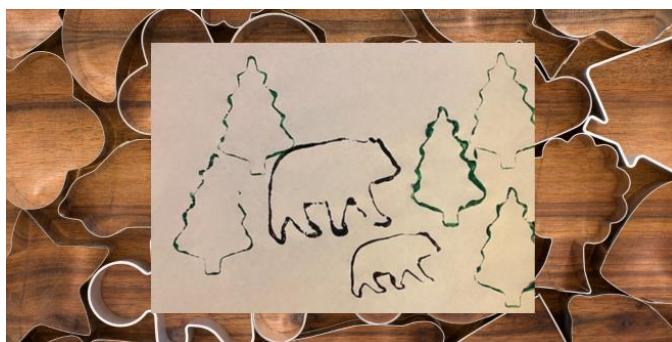


Cookie Cutter Stamping

‘Cookie Cutter Stamping’ is the perfect activity for creating your own story scenes and making use of all those cookie cutters you have stored away in the cupboard.



What you need

- Cookie cutters
- Paint
- Paint tray/plate
- Plain Paper or card

What to do

1. Add coloured paints to a tray or plate, give your child(ren) a piece of paper and set out some cookie cutters. Allow your child(ren) to stamp the cookie cutter into the paint and then stamp onto the paper.
2. Encourage older children to tell you a story about the cookie cutter characters or scene they are creating and ask them to give details to encourage descriptive language, for example: *“What do you think your bear's fur would feel like?” “How tall are the trees?”*

What they can learn

- Hand eye co-ordination
- Imagination and self-expression
- Telling their own stories
- Understanding cultural traditions
- To have fun and be creative!
